Route service 200: From **Salsburgh, Community Centre**, Carvale Avenue via Kirkview Avenue, Blackcroft Terrace, B7066, Salsburgh Main Street, Springfield Road, B7066, Glasgow and Edinburgh Road, Newhouse Roundabout, Edinburgh Road, Bo'ness Road, Woodhall Street, Lauchope Street, Chapelhall Main Street, A73 Carlisle Road, Clark Street, Graham Street, Gartlea Road, Bypass Road, Broomknoll Street, Stirling Street, Alexander Street, Monkscourt Avenue to **Monklands Hospital**.

Return from **Monklands Hospital** via Monkscourt Avenue then the reverse of the above route to B7066, Springfield Road, Salsburgh Main Street, B7066, Blackcroft Terrace, Camsdale Avenue to **Salsburgh Community Centre**, Carvale Avenue.

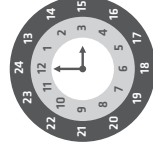
